Most of you know that my wife and I have been working in Africa for almost 39 years. I can't remember any Christmas when we did not do our best to raise thousands and thousands of dollars in order to share Jesus with millions of people in Africa, in the Ukraine, and here in America. We have been successful in seeing thousands come to Christ in all of our countries. And, we have been able to provide thousands of Bibles, Bible booklets, new convert materials, and on and on I could go! And, with the help of Samaritan's Purse in Boone, N.C., providing some wonderful hospital refurbishment equipment, we have been able to help restore three prison hospitals in Africa. In addition, with the help of so many of

God's people as individuals, in churches, in businesses, and in other organizations, God has provided for us so that we could help alleviate the suffering for millions of people caused by, the economy, wars, terrorist attacks, the Covid epidemic, a volcano eruption, imprisoned and dead husbands leaving widows and children behind, drought after drought, flood after flood, and many other dire situations. **God has truly blessed! But, there is so much more that needs to be done! SO WILL YOU PLEASE HELP US CONTINUE THIS GREAT MINISTRY THIS CHRISTMAS? I sincerely hope you can help us! I promise you that if you will, Jesus will bless you over and over (Matthew 10:42).**

THE COWS ARE COMING!!

A number of you that are our GIMI Team Members and Friends know that for many years that GIMI has bought hundred of beef cows to provide meat for the prisoners in Uganda on Christmas Day. We inherited this wonderful meat provision project from our Predecessors, Mickey and Alice Parrish, who started this great ministry while living in Jacksonville, Florida. And of course, it was while my family and I were living in Jacksonville where I was trying to complete my seminary training. It was down there that I began working in prisons with Brother Mickey, Jim Williams, and several others from the then great First Baptist Church. You might say I was broken in well because they took me straight to death row where I began to share Christ with a few unknown prisoners like, David Washington, Ted Bundy, and many other condemned prisoners. This was the beginning of mine and my wife's 47 years in the ministry for prisoners.

Now, let me get back to the cows! During last year's Christmas celebrations, we were not able to buy the cows in Uganda because of the Foot and Mouth disease which had spread all over the prison cow farms. So, we decided to go in another direction to buy other food items, plus, a huge amount of other humanitarian items. God gave a glorious time, especially because we were just coming out of the final months of the rapid Covid Crisis. **Because of God's graciousness and because of the sacrificial generous spirit of so many of you, folks, we were able to provide over \$100,000.00 worth of Christmas food, blankets, clothing, medicine, and small gifts to all of our 50 plus GIMI field workers in 12 African Countries and in the Ukraine. For this, we are still praising God!!!!**

WE BEG YOUR HELP ONCE AGAIN!

Let me tell you that I am very much aware of the fact that the last two years have been very difficult for common hard-working Americans! This has been caused by incompetent political leaders on both sides of the isle, plus, the horrible inflation that has been created by the destruction of our oil and gas production, by the evil lies about global warming which have demanded more and more money spent on something that is basically lies made up by money hungry politicians. But, probably more than anything, the huge rules and laws that have been implemented by evil liars without the vote of Congress and the Senate about oil and gas drilling, the need for windmills, getting rid of combustion engines, and on and on I could go, have taken down the income of almost every common class American. Yes, these are hard times caused by weak and soft politicians. But, may I tell you that the world needs the Gospel and the love of Christ shared through faithful servants who

are willing to give bountifully in a time when so few professing believers do. And, in Africa, where the average person lives on less than \$2.00 per day, the need is so enormous!! **So, this old 76 year old preacher is begging you to please help us again this Christmas! We are hoping to buy at least 70 cows this year. The cost has been dropped dramatically by the wonderful Commissioner General in Uganda, Dr. Johnson Byabashaija. Back in 1996 at Kigo Prison in Uganda, I had the wonderful privilege of leading Dr. Johnson to Christ! Ever since that day, Dr. Johnson has opened the prison doors wide open so that we can share the Gospel message and help the suffering of thousands of his prisoners! Dr. Johnson, we sincerely love and appreciate you so much!**

PLEASE HELP US PRAY FOR MY HEALTH TO GET BETTER IN ORDER TO RESTART THE RADIO MINISTRY ONCE MORE!

Most of you GIMI Team Members know that in our September/October newsletter I told you that due to more health problems, I have had to temporarily stop the radio ministry again because of health issues. Dear brothers and sisters, I love the radio ministry more than I could ever explain. I have done radio ministry since I started out in the ministry back in 1966. Through all of these years, we have seen literally thousands get saved through radio. Of course, you probably also know that over the past almost four years I have been very sick. The doctors can't determine what is wrong with me. And truthfully, many of these 25 plus doctors don't even care because I am an old person. You see, most doctors now days put on their soft euthanasia attitude rather than just try their best to help you. So, these past four years have been tough. But, with the help of Jesus and my sweet wife, I want to keep pressing toward the mark for Jesus until I cross the finish line!

Therefore, I want to ask all of you dear GIMI Friends to really help us pray that God might see fit

to restore my health so that I can get back to doing weekly radio broadcasts, and to continue on leading this great soul winning ministry. And, to be more specific, please pray that my up-and-down voice might get back to normal. Also, please pray that God will give me back my strength and energy once again. I have been so weak for the past few months that I have had a difficult time just completing the 30-minute weekly broadcasts. And also, please pray that God might touch the hearts of people to give a little extra again so that we can buy the airtime once again. Quite a few people stopped giving for the radio ministry when I got sick. But, this is quite understandable. Yet, if I can get the radio ministry started again, I hope we can expand the size of our listening audience by utilizing more stations! So, my dear beloved friends, On behalf of JoAnne and myself, I want to thank each of you who have helped with the radio expense in the past! And so, I hope you can be a vital part of this restored ministry in the near future!

Hopefully, Pastor Joel will be able to take another team to Africa again next year. If he does, I am sure that some of you might like to prayerfully consider going with him, while others of you might like to give some extra funds to help with the enormous expenses for these trips!

Well, I believe that by now, you believe it is time for me to stop writing. Therefore, I am stopping, although I would love to go on writing for a long time to come about the glorious privilege God has given to my precious wife and to me to be a part of this marvelous ministry for so long. Surely, God has had His hand upon this work since its very beginning. And, I pray that he will continue to do so indefinitely! Please know that JoAnne and I love you so very much!!

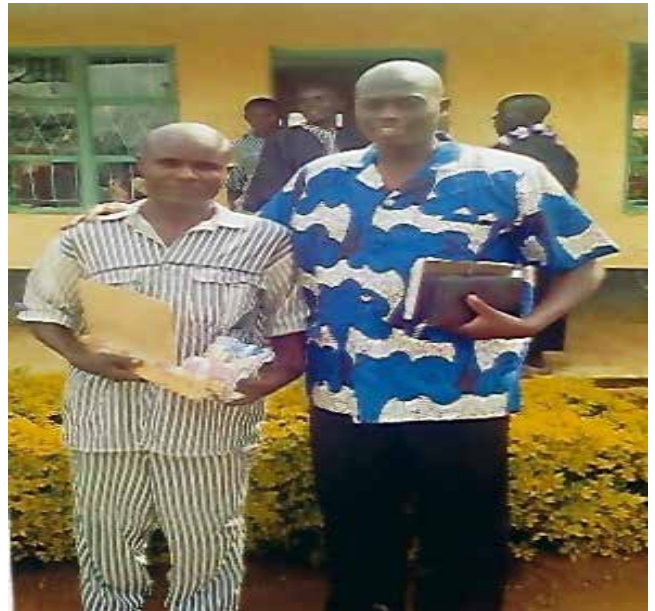

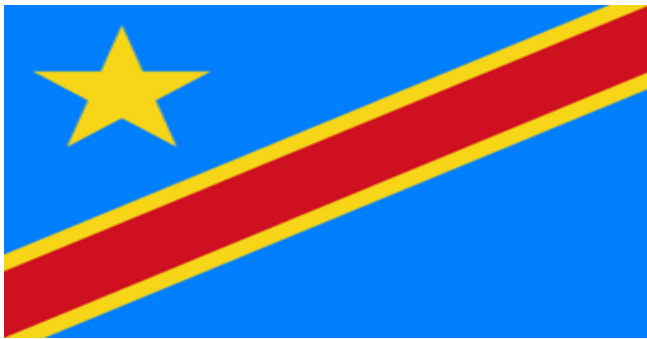

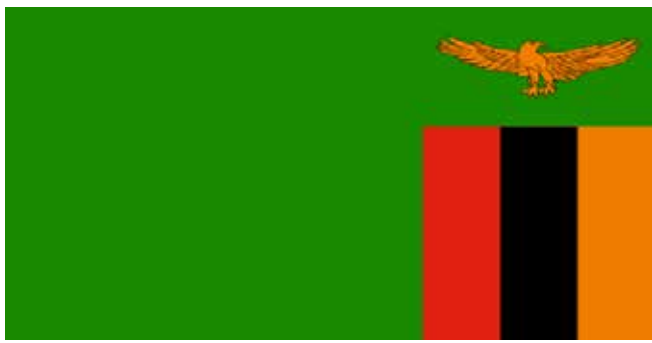
