lead this ministry for a while longer! (James 5:13-15) JoAnne and I want to thank all of you precious people who have stood with us for a long time in helping to support GIMI and this work. We still are praying that God will richly bless you for your investment in eternity through GIMI. And, I will tell you that surely your investment is bearing much fruit. I can readily and honestly tell you this because from January through July of this year (2023), God has made it possible for us to share the Gospel message with over 810,217 people in our 12 African countries. And, praise the Lord, He has given us a fruitful harvest of just over 173,926 people making first-time professions of faith. Because of your generous contributions to GIMI and, because God has led you to help us in this wonderful ministry, you will share equally in the rewards from Jesus at the Judgment Seat of Christ. A VERY NEEDED EXPLANATION CONCERNING OUR RADIO MINISTRY

I would like to share with all of you dear readers that when we were trying to print and publish our last newsletter, there was a computer problem, which resulted in our newsletter coming out very late. Therefore, because of this delay, I want to tell you that all of the information I gave you about our fruitful radio ministry came out late before I suddenly had to stop once again this ministry because of my deteriorating health conditions. God truly blessed our radio ministry with hundreds and hundreds of people getting saved. But, shortly after writing the last newsletter article, I became extremely weak, probably because of a low iron level. I went to the hospital and had a strong infusion of iron. But, this infusion made me extremely dizzy for seven days, which prevented me from being able to drive or do much of anything for that week. I had intended to have another infusion, but, because of the negative effects with the first infusion, I decided not to get another one. Thus, I still remain very weak, and because of this, it has been almost impossible for me to do the radio broadcasts in our radio room. So, for the time being, we have stopped the radio ministry once more until God will give me back some much needed strength. I am so saddened because of this. And, because I love the radio ministry so much due to God giving us such a great harvest of souls, I sincerely hope and pray that He will

give me back much strength so that we once again will be able to see hundreds and hundreds of people coming to Christ through the radio ministry, especially in some of our African countries. So, I would ask you to please keep helping us pray that God will see fit to provide the strength I need to restart the radio ministry for the third time.

I would like to share with you that if God does give me back some needed strength, I hope to do some training videos to help train and also encourage our workers in all of our countries. I have been working on the plan for these videos for quite a long time. The first video is going to be my presentation of the "Getting Started Right" material that I wrote for new converts and for those who want to grow in their new relationship with Jesus! Once the video is completed, we will do our best to get it into as many hands as possible on our fields of ministry, so that the new converts in the prisons, schools, orphanages, refugee camps, and in the churches might be helped to start well and continue to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus for a long time to come. After the completion of this video, I have many more that I hope to produce if God will indeed give me the strength to continue on with this great work for Jesus!

A NOTE OF APPRECIATION

Before I move on to give you some encouragement during these days of so many trials and uncertainties, I do want to offer a word of deep appreciation for all of our field workers in all of our African countries. Time or space won't permit me to list by name the 50 volunteers and workers in all of our 12 African countries who are faithfully working every day and every week to share the Gospel with so many thousands of people in the prisons, schools, orphanages, refugee camps, and churches. But, I do want to take this moment on behalf of my wife, JoAnne, our GIMI Board Members, and myself, to express from the depths of our hearts our deep gratitude to our workers for their faithful dedication and constant presentation in so many places to share the Gospel message with thousands and thousands of lost sinners who so desperately need to be saved. Truly, we have some of the most dedicated, faithful, and compassionate servants of God working consistently to help take the Good News of the Gospel to unlimited numbers of people in our 12 African countries. There is just no way that this ministry could continue on reaching so many thousands of people were it not for these precious friends and workers of GIMI. I want to tell all of you that we in the headquarters of GIMI are so very proud of you for the wonderful job you are doing. Thank you for being so dependable and consistent with your ministry. We truly love you, and we continue to pray for you every day. Without a doubt, you are going to reap great rewards when we stand before the Judgment Seat of Christ out in the future. As a small mission organization, we are truly privileged to have you representing our Savior and our leaders in a very difficult time in the world in which we live. May God continue to bless you and your families as we continue on with this great ministry while looking toward the Eastern skies for the return of our Savior and Lord! You are the greatest!

HELP IS MOST ASSUREDLY AVAILABLE!

I think everyone of you reading this Fall newsletter already knows that we are presently living in some of the most discouraging days that we have ever had to deal with in all of our lives, both here in our beloved America, and yes, in the rest of the world as well. If we are students of the Word of God, we most assuredly know that God has told us that just before the return of Christ, things would get worse and worse. In Matthew 24, in His Olivet discourse, Jesus informed His disciples that just before the rapture of the church and the coming reign of Antichrist, things would get worse and worse leading up to the cleansing and consummation of our present world just as they did in the days of Noah just before the cataclysmic flood came and destroyed everything except for Noah and his family who were safely in the big ark! Well, we are living right now in such a time once more.

And, I want to tell you that after being in fulltime ministry for 58 years, I have never seen so much discouragement and depression. But, this time if you or a family member or friend are going through dark depression, I want you to get out your Bible and turn to Psalms 142 and 143, and then study diligently these scriptures and closely read the two following sermon outlines I am giving to you. I truly pray that these might be a blessing to you, your family, and your friends. And, if they do help you, your family members, or friends, I would love for you to contact me and tell me about the help they have provided.

"THE CRY OF A DESPERATE MAN" SCRIPTURE: PSALM 142:1-7

Introduction:

As you begin to look into this wonderful passage of Scripture, I want to tell you that there is much disagreement among Bible scholars about which cave David was in when he wrote this Psalm. However, it would seem that most scholars believe that when David was in the cave where he wrote this Psalm, it was because he was running from King Saul who was trying to kill him. King Saul was a viciously jealous and insecure King who was threatened by anyone that seemed to be rising up in importance and significance. So, if this was the occasion of the writing of this Psalm, then it would probably be the cave of Adullam.

"The title tells us that this is a Psalm of David, written when he was in the cave. It does not tell us which cave, whether the Adullam or Engedi. Let us review David's experiences.

David's troubles as a young man came swiftly to a head at King Saul's court. After Saul had tried to have him murdered in his bed, he fled to Naioth. He had a secret meeting with his loyal friend Jonathan who promised to find out if it was safe for him to return home. Shortly afterward Jonathan returned for a clandestine meeting with David and warned him his life was in danger. By this time King Saul was under the tormenting influence of a demon. Nine times in two chapters he tried to have David murdered (I Samuel 19 and 20).

Thoroughly frightened, David fled to Philistia for political asylum. It was a disastrous move and he escaped from Gath only by feigning to be insane himself. Back in Israel, he sought refuge in the cave of Adullam, a big cave not far from the famous 'valley of the shadow.' It was a natural refuge for the beleaguered outlaw and for those who were allied to him. David's own family came to the cave about this time, it evidently being no longer safe for them to stay in Bethlehem. A growing band of desperados, refugees from Saul's excesses and injustices, found a natural leader in David. The frightened priest Abiathar also joined David after Saul's slaughter of his family and the priests of Nob. There was treachery every where at that time, even from the men of Keilah whose town David had rescued from the invaders."

Based upon all the information I can gather, it seems that David was fleeing from King Saul, and ended up in the Cave of Adullam, where he wound up in a devastating depressing and lonely and condition, wherefrom he wrote this cry to God for help. I sincerely pray that as you read and study this Psalm, you will be encouraged and helped to rise above your state of depression.

Conclusion:

Well friends, I hope and pray that you were challenged and blessed with the study of Psalm 142. If you were blessed and/or helped by this study, ^I pray that you will now apply the practical truth or principles God has given you to your daily life of depression. If you are still depressed and need a little counseling, please contact me. Then, I hope you will study carefully the next tremendous lesson we discover in Psalm 143.

"A CRY FROM THE DEPTHS OF DEPRESSION" SCRIPTURE: PSALM 143:1-12

Introduction:

Now, I would like to move forward to Psalm 143, where I pray that you will get some more help from Jesus for your continuing devastating depression which seems to have you in prison.

I would tell you that David's origin in this cave is still up for discussion by many scholars. But, I believe it is probably the cave he hid in when, Absalom, his own son set out to destroy him and to steal his kingdom. Truthfully, in my study of which cave David was hiding out in when he wrote this Psalm, it would seem that this might be the same cave he was hiding in when King Saul was trying to kill him as well. If it is, then it must be the cave of Adullam. But regardless of which cave David was in at this time, it is extremely obvious that he was being pursued by Absalom, his own son, who had vowed to kill his father and steal the Kingdom of Israel. May I tell you that I believe this story is one of the saddest stories in all of the Bible, and yes, even in the history of the entire world.

David was a magnificent King, even with his history of immorality and murder. And, regardless of what David had done wrong, there was nothing he had done that deserved to have his own son try to steal the kingdom from his father. Of course, if you are familiar with this story (II Samuel 15), you know that Absalom suffered a horrible death because of his rebellion against his father. But, before this tragic event took place, David was hiding out in probably the Cave of Adullam for the second time when he

wrote this beautiful cry for God's help. Let me ask you to taken your depression and bring it to Jesus for His healing touch!

Conclusion:

THE HUGE CHALLENGE STILL BEFORE US!

This is the third time I am going to finalize my article for our GIMI newsletter by sharing two very important messages with you once more. First, on behalf of my precious wife, I want to thank every one of you dear people who have helped us keep this ministry going for such a long time. I want to thank all of you prayer warriors here in America and in our other countries that pray for GIMI and the progress of this great ministry faithfully. Truly, we have never been a big organization at any time in the past. Presently, we only have three people working for GIMI here in America. But, because so many of you pray regularly for us, we have been able to do big things with the help of our Lord Jesus Christ and the 50 devoted people that work with us presently in our 12 countries in Africa. Then too, when we have our special mission teams that are willing to sacrificially take the long trips to Africa, (like Pastor Joel and his two recent teams) from time to time to help us present the Gospel message, we are then able to see hundreds and hundreds more people get saved. And, this wonderful help from our Savior and Lord has been given to us because of your faithfulness to pray for us, and to give consistently financially to this to help us with this great work for Jesus!

Then secondly, I would like to just mention to you again that God is still opening doors for us in our present countries in Africa, and He is opening more doors for us here in America as well. Also, God is opening many new doors in other countries in Africa where we have never gone before. And, in spite of the fact that I have had to stop broadcasting our radio broadcasts once

more because of my health, I sincerely believe that God is going to give me extra strength soon to restart the radio ministry for the third time. Also, with my personal struggle with health issues, it is very hard for me to travel to churches here in America, and for certain, it is impossible for me to travel internationally at this time. Thus, I am so grateful for my son, Pastor Joel Frye, who has volunteered to help us by taking some American mission teams to Africa when I cannot go. Hopefully, Pastor Joel might be able to take another team to Africa again this year. If he does, I am sure that some of you might like to prayerfully consider going with him, while others of you might like to give some extra funds to help with the enormous expenses for these trips!

Well, I believe that by now, you believe it is time for me to stop writing. Therefore, I am stopping, although I would love to go on writing for a long time to come about the glorious privilege God has given to my precious wife and to me to be a part of this marvelous ministry for so long. Surely, God has had His hand upon this work since its very beginning. And, I pray that he will continue to do so indefinitely! Please know that JoAnne and I love you so very much!!!
