We have traveled millions of miles in this awesome effort to win multitudes for Christ. We can bow on our knees and lift up our hands in prayer and worship Jesus for the unique privilege He has given us to represent Him and His Kingdom for this long period of time. And, in spite of the naysayers (like a staff member in a church in Spring Lake, NC) who tried to promote doubt with other believers and churches to give an excuse for discontinuing support for this great Modern-Day Book of Acts Ministry, God has truly blessed GIMI with a huge harvest of souls for the past 24 years. It is absolutely unbelievable how God has poured out His Spirit to bless all of our workers in all of our African countries. During the past 24 years since JoAnne and I took over this wonderful ministry from Brother Mickey and Sister Alice Parrish, GIMI has shared the Gospel with over 35 million people with just over 6.3 million of these dear people making a first-time decision to follow Christ. This would be a good time to shout glory hallelujah and praise to His mighty name!

Yes, dear friends, truly, truly, God is the One to be praised and glorified for this huge harvest of souls coming to Jesus. But, this could never have happened were it not for our devoted and faithful workers in all of our African countries, plus, in the war-torn Ukraine. Without a doubt, God has given to our ministry some of the most devoted people that I have ever seen during my pastorate of thousands of people in eleven churches!

Also, I must tell you that none of this precious ministry would have ever been possible, were it not for the prayerful loving sacrificial giving of so many of you dear people to

GIMI! I want to tell you emphatically that not only has God used our field workers, our American staff and mission teams, but, He has gloriously provided a huge amount of dollars to keep this ministry going after lost souls. And, as I have told you many times before, I desire that God's truly saved people will have on their hearts what Jesus has on His. Notice this Scripture found in Luke 19:10, "For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost." We as God's children must come to understand that the main reason God gloriously saves us is to place on our hearts what Jesus has on His; the lost souls all around us, and yes, all around the world! And, He saves us to place us in His soul-winning army to help take the Gospel message to as many people as we possibly can in the time we have left before He returns! In continuing on with my rejoicing over the great harvest of souls that God has been giving us, I would like to tell you that during 2023, our GIMI workers and Pastor Joel Frye's June mission teams, plus, our on and off radio ministry have been privileged to share the love of Jesus with over 1,570,004 people in Africa, in the Ukraine, and yes, here in America. And from this large number of people, we have seen over 350,108 people make first-time professions of faith in Christ in just twelve months. Now, we are doing our best to follow up on as many of these people as possible by providing Bibles, my new convert booklet, entitled "Getting Started Right." We also do our best to get these new converts to be baptized in water and become a part of a conservative church in their area. Of course, many of our converts are prisoners. Therefore, these prisoners are encouraged to become a part of the prison church fellowship, which most of the prisons have. But, there are some very skeptical people in this world who want to know if I believe all of these people really have been genuinely saved. My answer is absolutely not! But, I don't believe that all people who make professions of faith in our churches are genuinely saved. And, according to the Parable of the Sower in Matthew 13:18-23, only one of the soils was genuine. Therefore, we must understand that probably only 25% of those who make professions of faith are really genuine. Thus, would you suggest that we should stop taking the Gospel message to the entire world? I don't believe you would! Therefore, we must continue on making sure that we present the Gospel to as many people as possible. So, my dear GIMI support team, will you continue to help us share the Gospel with thousands of people? If you will, my dear wife and I, along with our workers, will continue to push on with this marvelous work and ministry!

## Please Be Blessed By The following Testimonies!!

### I. Testimony One: By: Okerwa Justine

My name is Okwera Justine. I was born in 1985 and immediately the next year my father died in the war in Northern Uganda. So, I remained with my mother who is from Pakwach. I grew up, studied and took a wife in 2020. I found that I could not continue to live with my family from my mother's side. I then relocated to my father's village in Odek where I was surprised to meet an evil, corrupt, violent and wicked member who started begrudging me land.

I tried to seek the help of my family elders all in vain. They sold land from which they paid for their behaviors. I came to identify that two women were even preaching sorcery itself, yet I knew and believed that the almighty God through Jesus Christ would guide and protect me for the time I was there.

After the almighty God blessed me with a child as we worked hard for two years. The cousin's brothers of mine became more cruel, and did several fatal attempts against my family's. They planned to imprison me and take over my crops in the fields evicting me from the land.

They then sold and bribed a certain man who forced his daughters to state to police that I had defiled and child trafficked them. I had reported to police and the police knew I was innocent, but they were paid. So, I was charged and remanded in prison.

In prison I gave my life to Christ. The Gospel saved me from committing suicide and giving up to death as suffering innocently is more painful and harder than those committed the offence. The Almighty God has blessed me and promised to take care and protect me till the time I shall be set free. I avoid anything to do with sin from lust to anger. And, I am ever feeling the abundant grace of God through his only begotten Son, Jesus Christ. I would like to thank GIMI pastor Patrick Ogaba and GIMI for helping to

support our prisoners.

### II. Testimony Two: By: Richard Okello

My name is Okello Richard, born again grew up in a mixed Christian family. My mother is a staunch born again lady and my father was a real drunkard Catholic. I never used to take born again issues seriously. I could do my own things. But being the only boy in the family, my mother was determined to convert me, although, I was reluctant and stubborn. I could hardly listen to her. This took many years. My mum never gave up. She kept on pressing harder and harder.

Sincerely, my life was characterized by only dubious acts, and I was soon becoming a community misfit. This kept on haunting me until 2019, when my journey to salvation became real.

It all started when I lost my one million shillings. And, this still baffled me how the money disappeared from my pocket. I was really confused and decided to go to a native doctor (a witch doctor) upon listening to an advertisement from one of the radio stations with us. The advertisement was that "Those native doctors can help you recover your lost property." So, I thought that I was going to recover mine too.

When I contacted one of the native doctors, he directed me to his place opposite Layibi Primary School. He added that I should come along with 25,000 shillings (about \$8.00) as a consultation fee of which I went with. Upon paying the consultation, he demanded 75,000 shillings (About \$24.00) as transport to his people (demons), and this money will facilitate their movement to get the thief. I again paid. He assured me that within 6 hours, the thief will bring my money up to my home. So, I went up to my home and waited in vain.

Today later, he called me to go and see where my money is. Stupidly, I went to him. This time he demanded an additional 350,000 Shillings (\$100.00) before showing me where my money is. Immediately, I came to my senses and realized that the man is playing a game, and the entire thing looks like a scam. So, I declined paying the 350,000 Shillings. (In fact, I was not having that amount.) The man (native doctor) became furious and started threatening me that if don't pay the said amount, he will send his people (demons) after me, and I must find away a way of transporting them back to Mombasa where he was bringing them from.

At this point my eyes were opened and I became brave and boldly told him that I cannot meet his demand. He continued threatening me and I left after exchanging a few bitter words.

In my heart, I was also fearing that he may send his demons to attack me. That same evening I went straight to the village, narrated everything to my mum. She installed courage in me and prayed for me. My uncle and his wife also prayed for me. The next day my mum took me to a local church where she fellowships. The senior pastor prayed and I got saved there and then. Since then nothing wrong has happened to me in regards to the native doctor's threat. I continued to be a good believer, all the dubious acts I used to do were gone. I became a complete new creature.

Another set back came in 2022, when I was accused and got arrested for a crime I didn't commit. This broke my heart. I felt rejected and betrayed. Everything seemed so unusual when brought to prison. I thought my life had ended. I was completely forsaken. I started asking God "why did He allow this to happen to me?" I felt that God no longer loved me.

Whenever my wife and other people came to visit me, I could cry and this kept happening for the first five months. I could no longer hold anymore since I was just four months into my marriage. I kept asking myself, "Why God allowed me to wed this girl if He knew that I was going to stay with her just for only four months. Sincerely, I thought my faith was really tampered with, and I decided to blame God. But, after a few days one inmate came to me to share the Word of God.

In I John 2:15-17, (about not loving the world), I was comforted and became energized, after daily and continuously sharing the words of God with others, I renewed my relationship with God and currently I am back with Christ. I only count on Him, and I strongly believe one day He (God) will deliver me from this bondage (prison). I will go home and continue with my remaining part of life peacefully.

### **III. Testimony Three: by: Denis Nina**

"Greetings to you in the precious name of Jesus. I am called Nina Denis, and I am from the Acholi Tribe in eastern equatorial South Sudan living now in the refugee camp, Bidibidi settlement. All of my life in South Sudan was very good and peaceful in our family, especially my life.

Unfortunately, in 2016 when the war started at the area, we were staying in South Sudan. During the war I lost both of my parents, and life became difficult from my side, we had nowhere to stay. The only solution was to leave the country and flee to Uganda to a place called refugee camp Bidibidi settlement where my brother and I have lived up till now. Life wasn't easy for me and my family, though there was support from the UN, it was not an easy in term of feeding and accommodation. Personally, I thought of committing suicide, but it could not work because worst of all, I was the eldest person in the family. Things became hard for me, whereby, I joined peer groups and my life was changed from the things I used not to do; like drinking alcohol, stealing from my neighbor, adultery, smoking and etc. All of this happened to my life.

It was not until in 2019, when a pastor from GIMI Ministry, Rev. Chaplain Mogga, visited our camp with gifts from GIMI Ministry, he shared with us the Word of God from the Book of Genesis, chapter 3, on the fall of man. His theme was in verse 9, where God asked, "Where are you?" I was convinced and accepted Jesus Christ as my Lord and personal Savior. I was given a tool of my new life that day. That day I got a Bible and other support from GIMI Ministry. From that day up to now, my life has changed dramatically for the past six months since my salvation. After getting saved, I received the calling from God giving me different gifts for serving Him, singing in the choir, preaching the Word of God, and even leadership knowledge in the ministry. By the grace of God in 2023, I was recommended for further study at UCU branch, Uganda Martyrs' Seminary Numugongo to become an ordained minister in 2026.

I want to take my vote to thank GIMI Ministry for the support toward the needy, both physical and spiritual support above all for what they have done for my life and through GIMI Ministry today I am God's servant. May God richly bless this ministry as you continue to serve God and His people."

### **IV. Testimony Four: By: Emmanuel Caku**

Praise the Lord Jesus Christ! I am Emmanuel Caku from Maga-MAGU church in the Kiryando Refugee settlement, and from the tribe Muru from Sudan, would like to send my sincere greetings and thanks to the Ministry of GIMI for the great work you are doing since 2019 up to this date. We are especially grateful for your support of elderly people, sick people, disabled people, and orphans and wid-



ows with their needs.

GIMI has also played a very big role by supporting Christian ministry with Bibles and Bible study guides. Not only this, but also during the Covid-19, GIMI played a very big role by supporting many people with soap for washing their hands to reduce the spread of Covid-19.

At that time after receiving a Bible, we from Bible study groups where we got to know more about the Scriptures, I was convicted and got gloriously saved when the GIMI preacher, Chaplain Mogga, asked who has believed our message and to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed (Isaiah 53:1). I stood to confess my sin to the Lord. Later I was recommended to join the theological seminary at Uganda Martyrs' Seminary Namugongo from (2021-23). In August I was supported by GIMI Ministry from the beginning to the end of my studies with the scholastic studies. After my studies, by the grace of the Lord I was ordained a preacher of the Gospel on 24/September/ 2023.

Indeed, GIMI Ministry has supported thousands of people and empowered very many people including me for the ministry of God, and many people get convicted and saved. Therefore, I congratulate the GIMI Ministry for the support rendered for me and God's people. Thanks!

#### **IV. Testimony Four: By: Rev. Charles Taban**

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ! I am Rev., Charles Taban, a born again servant. I accepted Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior in the year, 2000, and so far I have served in more than three parishes. I am indeed happy with Chaplain Mogga Leju, who is a preacher with GIMI Ministry. He chose me to be a member, surely I got rooted and built up in Christ, meaning my faith is now dependent upon him because we are united in love preaching the good news to many people.

Sometimes we visit prisons like Dyang and Kidi-dima government prisons taking some assistance like soap and also praying/feeding them spiritually. Many of the prisoners have accepted Jesus Christ to be their God and Savior.

We also do minister to the children and youth where many have turned back to God offering their lives to Him. As they were given Bibles, they started forming groups for Bible study.

We do visit the sick, poor/needy, orphans and widows, praying, preaching, giving them Posho (corn flour) and soap where they are so appreciative of GIMI for loving and caring for them. May God richly bless you!

So, in view of the fact that my health is not allowing much travel these days, I do pray that some of you dear GIMI friends and supporters will consider joining our son in helping us to continue telling the world about Jesus! I will close by telling you that if you join Pastor Joel and the teams, you will come home never the same again!

## THE HUGE CHALLENGE STILL BEFORE US!

At the risk of being repetitious, I am going to finalize my article for our GIMI newsletter once more by sharing two very important messages with you again. First, on behalf of my precious wife, I want to thank every one of you dear people who have helped us keep this ministry going for such a long time. I want to thank all of you prayer warriors here in America and in our other countries that pray for GIMI and the progress of this great ministry faithfully. Truly, we have never been a big organization at any time in the past. Presently, we only have three people working for GIMI here in America. But, because so many of you pray regularly for us, we have been able to do big things with the help of our Lord Jesus Christ and the 50 devoted people that work with us presently in our 12 countries in Africa. Then too, when we have our special mission teams that are willing to sacrificially take the long trips to Africa, (like Pastor Joel and his two recent teams) from time to time to help us present the Gospel message, we are then able to see hundreds and hundreds more people get saved. And, this wonderful help from our Savior and Lord has been given to us because of your faithfulness to pray for us, and to give consistently financially to this to help us with this great work for Jesus!

Then secondly, I would like to just mention to you again that God is still opening doors for us in our present countries in Africa, and He is opening more doors for us here

in America as well. Also, God is opening many new doors in other countries in Africa where we have never gone before. And, in spite of the fact that I had to stop broadcasting our radio broadcasts once more because of my health, I sincerely believe that God is going to give me extra strength soon to restart the radio ministry for the third time. And hopefully, by the time you receive this Janaury/February edition of our GIMI newsletter, I hope to be back on the air presenting the Gospel by the means of radio. Also, with my personal struggle with health issues, it is very hard for me to travel to churches here in America to raise funds for our ministry, especially for restarting the radio broadcasting. Therefore, I do pray that many of you might really be inspired of the Lord to help finance the radio work in order to reach literally thousands of lost people for Jesus!

Also, for certain, it is impossible for me to travel internationally at this time. Thus, I am so grateful for my son, Pastor Joel Frye, who has volunteered to help us by taking some American mission teams to Africa when I cannot go. As I told you, Pastor Joel will be taking two more teams to Africa again this year. If he does, I am sure that some of you might like to prayerfully consider going with him, while others of you might like to give some extra funds to help with the enormous expenses for these trips!

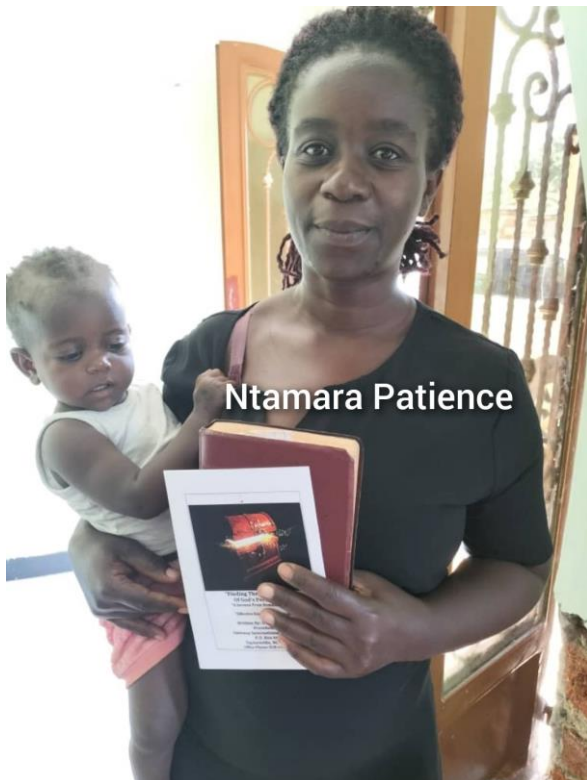

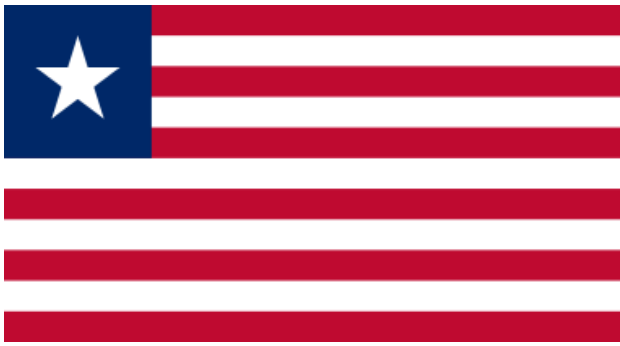

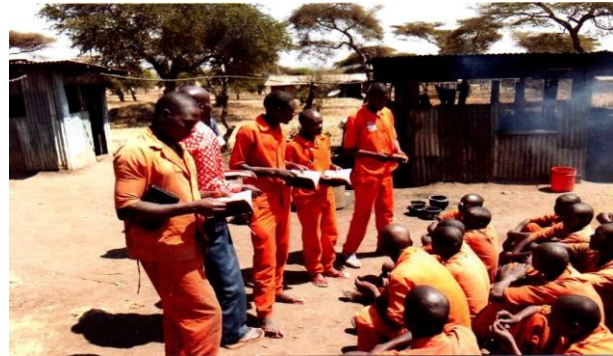
