We just praise the Lord for His saving power! And, because so many of you have helped us, we have given millions of dollars worth of humanitarian items to all of our African fields of ministry. We never could have done this without dear friends like you helping us so regularly. Jo Anne and I want to thank each of you GIMI Team Members for what you have given. You indeed will share equally in the rewards for the souls that have been saved and the lives that have been changed, especially in the lives of thousands and thousands of prisoners, students, and orphans. What a privilege it has been to have you investing in this wonderful work for Jesus!

Truly, It Is A Time For Thanksgiving!

It is very hard for me to believe that another complete year has gone by, but it is now time for a great celebration of God's goodness and blessings to all of our GIMI Team Members, and to the multitude of recipients who have received the spiritual and physical blessings through the ministry of GIMI. In fact, just this year alone during the virus pandemic, God has given us a harvest of over 90,000 first-time decisions for Christ from the large number of 500,000 people who have received the message of the love of Jesus. Truly, God has His hand upon this ministry, and all that my wife and I desire is to get more people involved in the work by prayer, by financial gifts, and by many of you participating in our short-term mission trips when everything opens up again after this pandemic crisis.

Every year here in America our nation still has a day of Thanksgiving during the month of November. The only problem is that many just offer thanksgiving to their family and friends, while the purpose of this established day was to give thanksgiving and adoration to God. When you study the history of the first Thanksgiving in the new world, you will discover two events on two different dates.

"Thanksgiving services were routine in what became the Commonwealth of Virginia as early as 1607, with the first permanent settlement of Jamestown, Virginia holding a thanksgiving in 1610. In 1619, 38 English settlers arrived at Berkeley Hundred in Charles City County, Virginia. The group's London Company Charter specifically required 'that the day of ships arrival at the place assigned.....in the land of Virginia shall be yearly and perpetually kept holy as a day of thanksgiving to Almighty God.' Three years later, after the Indian massacre of 1622, the Berkeley Hundred site and other outlying locations were abandoned and colonists moved their celebration to Jamestown and other more secure spots."1

The second date given for the first-time celebration of Thanksgiving Day is listed as October, 1621. Let me give you more information from Wikipedia.

"The event that Americans commonly call the 'First Thanksgiving' was celebrated by the Pilgrims after their first harvest in the New World in October, 1621. This feast lasted three days, and—as recounted by attendee Edward Winslow, was attended by 90 Native Americans and 53 Pilgrims. The New England colonists were accustomed to regularly celebrating 'thanksgivings,' days of prayer thanking God for blessings such as a military victory or the end of a drought. Thanksgiving has been celebrated nationally on and off since 1789, with a proclamation by President George Washington after a request by Congress. President Thomas Jefferson chose not to observe the holiday, and its celebration was intermittent until President Abraham Lincoln, in 1863, proclaimed a national day of 'Thanksgiving and Praise to our beneficent Father who dwelleth in the heavens', to be celebrated on the last Thursday in November. On June 28, 1870, President Ulysses S. Grant signed into law the 'Holidays Act' that made Thanksgiving a yearly appointed federal holiday in Washington, DC. On January 6, 1885, an act of Congress made Thanksgiving, and other federal holidays, a paid holiday for all federal workers throughout the United States. Under President Franklin D. Roosevelt, the date was changed between 1939 and 1941 amid significant controversy. From 1942 onwards, Thanksgiving, by an act of Congress, signed into law by FDR, received a permanent observation date, the fourth Thursday in

November, no longer at the discretion of the President."2

Now, with this long history behind us in just a short description, let me tell you that "Thanksgiving Day", should be a very special time of the year for every grateful American. We truly do have a great country, even with all of the violence and wicked behavior during this year 2020. But truthfully, this nation would never have lasted as long as it has were it not founded upon the truth and principles of the Word of God by our forefathers. Thus, we are indebted to these fearless people who demonstrated their courage in establishing this nation on Biblical principles. God has truly blessed my family and me in the past, and we are trusting Him to give me the privilege to do what I would rather do more than any thing on earth, and that is to preach and teach the word of God without difficulty once again!

I must tell you that down through the many years of full-time ministry, I have preached and taught over and over that the greatest day of the year is when we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. We Are Expanding Our Ministry To The BidiBidi Refugee Camp In Northern Uganda!

A couple months back, I was watching the John Ankerburg program on Christian Television when he was discussing the large BidiBidi Refugee Camp in northern Uganda. This camp is the second largest refugee camp in the world. The only one larger is found in Turkey. This camp has over 300,000 people in it. During that discussion, I began to see that this refugee camp is located near another one that our GIMI preacher Mogga Leju is already working in each month. The camp that Mogga has already been working in is the Kiryandongo Camp. Both of these camps are refugees from South Sudan who have had to flee their home country because of the civil war going on there since 2013. The Kiryandongo Camp, where we are already working, has over 100,000 refugees in it. Most of these are women and children, including many young teenagers.

When I saw the challenge about the BidiBidi Camp, I contacted Pastor Mogga. He was already much aware of this even larger camp. I asked him to prayerfully consider starting a new ministry in this huge camp. And folks, this past month, he began another great ministry there. So, we are now ministering to two huge camps in northern Uganda, two large camps in the DR Congo, and sometimes, even in southwest Uganda, where there are a huge number of refugees from the DRC and some from Rwanda. Folks, I have just been extremely burdened about these thousands and thousands of people, who for the most part are being neglected, except for some government organizations that do not share the Gospel message with these suffering people. Therefore, I am asking all of you to really pray for this new, very expansive work. Pray that God will give us thousands of souls in a great harvest for Him. Also, pray that God will meet the needs so that we can really reach out to these neglected and forgotten people.

Let me mention one more thing before moving on. Because of the Covid 19 virus pandemic, right now we are being restricted or limited in what we can do in some of the prisons in some of our countries, especially Uganda, therefore, it is a very good time for us to expand our territory as Jabez prayed for in I Chronicles, Chapter Four. So, I do pray that God might give us the personnel, the funds, and the wisdom to enlarge our outreach territory there in the country of Uganda. Without a doubt, God has opened these new doors. And, I would ask many of you pastors and church leaders to really consider helping us carry out this new refugee ministry by giving a little more monthly or by even taking a special offering to help us this year with the Christmas parties.

We Are Working On Our Next Mission Teams Trips To Africa for 2021.

Folks, this year has been a very difficult time for planning and making mission trips to our African mission fields because of the horrible coronavirus and all of the shutdowns, the grounded flights, and the necessary social distancing. (Of course, the protestors and rioters walking hand in hand and arm in arm really didn't matter. But, it was those "old hard-headed pastors and churches" that have caused so many problems!)

But now, as I am bringing this newsletter article to a close, I want to tell you that we are taking some big steps of faith and moving ahead with planning our mission team trips for 2021. I am going to give you the projected dates for the next trips, and then, we will give you the particulars in the next newsletter. So, take a look at these projected dates, and prayerfully consider going on one of these wonderful trips.

- 1. March 8-21, 2021- Evangelism Trip to Uganda
- 2. June 7-19, 2021- Medical and Evangelism Trip to Kenya.
- 3. October 4-16, 2021- Evangelism and Training Trip to Uganda, the DRC, and Rwanda.

Let me close by asking everyone of you who is a truly devoted and sold-out believer to sincerely consider joining us for one of these life-changing mission trips. Also, let me beg all of you to really pray for all of our teams that will be going if the virus pandemic is killed by God. Pray for good health, safety in the air and on the roads in all the countries, and most of all, please pray for a huge harvest of souls to come to Christ.
