These many years of working with Pastor Odell in revival meetings were some of the greatest years that I have ever enjoyed. And that is saying a lot, because I have preached over 1,300 revival meetings in 33 USA states.

Several years ago, Pastor Odell's first wife, Patsy, passed on to heaven, and I was invited to go to Texas and conduct her memorial celebration. During that service, the church was packed with people, and when I gave the invitation, 17 adult people got saved and gave their hearts to Jesus! What a day of celebration that was!

After Sister Patsy went to heaven, some time went by, and Odell married another precious lady named Linda. Linda has been such a wonderful gift to her husband, the family, and to the church family! Also, she has been a dear friend to my wife and me. I would like to ask you to really pray for Sister Linda and the entire family, and then, pray also fervently for North Bay Fellowship as they transition to another full-time pastor. Pray that God will give the church leadership the same lost-soul vision that Pastor Odell maintained for all of those years as their senior pastor. Due to Dr. Peal's leadership, this new school was getting ready for its third year with almost 200 students. But as so often happens, God had other plans for Dr. Peal. On Monday, July 19, 2021, he travelling with a friend back up to his home state of Ohio, when he had a terrible vehicle accident and

was killed. Dr. Peal was 57 years old, and he leaves behind his dear wife, Renee, and three adult children, whom he loved so very much. He also had three grandchildren that he loved tremendously.

Truly, Dr. Peal was a great inspiration to his family, his church family, his school team, and anyone that knew him well for any length of time. He will sincerely be missed by everyone. Please join us in praying that God will send another "Jeffrey Peal" to take over the growing school, which he so suddenly vacated. Our community here needs another person of his caliber to come in and lead Millersville Christian Academy on to greater depths in God's Word and to greater heights in teaching God's infallible Christian world view to our children during these days when the public schools are being destroyed by the C.R.T. training, and by the growing immorality of young people and yes, even the teachers as well. A Personal Update About My Health

Most of you who read our newsletter know that for over 11 months, I have been very sick with a serious digestive condition, which 13 doctors can't seem to diagnose. In addition, I had the vocal cord surgery back on April 27th. This has really helped my voice and the ability to preach and teach. But, the digestive problem has become very severe. As stated, I have visited 13 doctors, had 18 serious tests, and have been put to sleep five times for the gall bladder and vocal cord surgeries, plus, I have had two endoscopies. Five of my doctors have disagreed with the other eight about what is wrong with me. My cardiologist is now recommending that I go either to the Cleveland Clinic, Duke Hospital, or the Mayo Clinic.

But truthfully, right now I just don't know what to do. However, my cardiologist is going to try some more heart tests very soon in relationship to how my heart may be affecting my digestive system. So, as we struggle with "what's next", please help Jo Anne and me pray to know the will of God. Yet, truthfully, we have been praying fervently that God will supernaturally heal my problem with no more doctors or surgeries. Therefore, I want to ask all of you to really pray for God to heal me, so that I can get back to carrying out this great ministry, travel to Africa again when this virus is gone, travel to churches and cities in order to share the story of GIMI, and hopefully, to raise more funds so that this work can go on for a long time to come. I am praying that I don't have to stop working because of sickness when there are so many people in the world that yet need to be saved.

Radio Ministry Update

Now, let me share with you that I am still working on getting our Radio Ministry back up and going very soon. I recently started preparing some new broadcasts, but I did have some tremendous weakness when I attempted the production of these new programs. Therefore, please pray that God will not only improve my speech with the new vocal cord implants, but that He will heal this digestive problem so that I can have the strength to begin the

production of all of our radio programs. I desire this so much, and truly, right now with all of the COVID virus problems, there is no greater way to get the Gospel out to the lost, when so many of our churches and mission ministries have been restricted. So, please keep praying that God will give me the health to restart our Radio Ministry, and that He will provide the \$44,000 that we will need for one entire year's worth of broadcasting on at least 65 stations, like we had going before my voice got so bad.

Therefore, I am asking all of you GIMI Prayer and Support Team members to pray fervently about these special needs. Also, we will welcome and thank God for any financial support you might be able to give to restart this endeavor. I just pray that by the time you might receive this newsletter, we might already have the Radio Ministry up and going again! Pray that God might save a lot of souls through this revived ministry, and that He might help scores of people grow in the grace of God. Please pray that as these growing believers get closer to Jesus, they will have on their hearts what Jesus has on His heart: "The souls of men, women, boys and girls". Please, let's never forget that according to Luke 19:10, Jesus came to seek and save the lost." Please meditate on this verse: "For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."

Please Pray For The Following Prayer Requests!

I have already shared many things for all of you team members to pray about with us. But, I would like to mention some other needs which beg for fervent prayer. First, please pray for the families of the departed souls that we payed tribute to earlier. Please pray for their wellbeing, for their personal and family needs, and for their mental and emotional support during this very difficult time. More than anything, please help us pray that God might turn their present loss and gloom into something good for their families and friends. Then, let's pray that God might bless these lonely and suffering people with such spiritual comfort and blessing that they might in turn give Jesus glory right now, in this time of grief and gloom!

Now, after Don came home from the hospital with the terrible COVID experience, he has ended up getting very sick and being diagnosed with Acute Leukemia. He is back in the hospital for blood transfusions, chemotherapy, strong antibiotics, and many other medicines. Please help us pray that God might spare Brother Don's life and restore his health for a long time to come!

Introduction

It is very obvious that we are presently living in the last days before the Second Coming of our wonderful Lord Jesus Christ. Before Jesus returned to Heaven, He gave to His disciples many signs that would indicate that His return was not far off. One of these signs, described in Jesus' Olivet discourse in Matthew 24:11, is that before the coming of the Lord Jesus, there would be many false prophets on the earth who would so imitate genuine prophets and preachers, that many would be deceived. Further on in Matthew 24:24-26, Jesus said, "For there shall arise false Christ's, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect. Behold, I have told you before. Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers: believe it not." In other words, as we get closer to the return of Christ, there will be a proliferation of false deceivers who demonstrate miraculous looking signs and miracles, which will draw people away from the truth of the Word of God. This is so evident in the Neo-charismatic movement and Neo-Pentecostalism of today.

Let me be quick to mention that I do not believe that every person involved in the Charismatic movement is evil or phony. Yet, it surely does seem that multitudes are, because what they practice does not align with scriptural truth. As a matter of fact, I am convinced that the primary reason for the errors of the Charismatic movement is that they base much of their doctrine on some mystical experience they supposedly have had, and then they go to the scriptures to find a proof text to prove the experience's authenticity. May the Lord help us to always remember that we must judge any spiritual experience we have with the truth of the Word of God, interpreted within the context and the greater context of the passage! Without this kind of Biblical interpretation, we descend to the level of the cults, such as the Mormons and Jehovah's Witnesses, who approach the Bible in this erroneous way. If the Neo-Charismatics would turn to sound Hermeneutical principles of Biblical interpretation, they would lose many of their far out teachings. I believe that they would also ultimately get out of this shallow Christianity, which produces weird and sometimes even silly behavior. It is so sad that scores of non-believers are becoming completely alienated from the true Gospel of Jesus Christ due to the extreme excesses of people who probably mean well, but yet function in a vacuum of Biblical ignorance. It is also equally sad that multitudes of church parishioners are fleeing from dead churches, only to be seduced and deceived by the emotional and "feel good" experiences of the Charismatics. What is happening today within the churches should be a wakeup call to every bishop and pastor in the world. We must move away from our dead formalized religion to the proclamation of a dynamic living relationship with Jesus Christ. Only when we offer the true spiritual life produced by personal salvation and a daily developing relationship with the resurrected Lord will we slow down and eventually stop the mass exodus of those who are looking for more than cold dead formalism in their lives.

The purpose of this seminar is to help us as church leaders to open our eyes to the damage that is being done to individual Christians in particular and to thousands of churches collectively by the misguided efforts of the modern Charismatics. And then, we must resolve in our hearts to take a loving stand against this present day attack on the church by exposing the falsehoods and by presenting the truth of a living exciting relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ as opposed to mere dry and dead ritual. It is wrong to have a "form of godliness while denying the power thereof"! We cannot curse the darkness without turning on the light!!!

It is my sincere prayer that this brief one day seminar will be used by God to challenge us to CHANGE! Change never comes easy, but it is absolutely mandatory for growth in our personal lives, as well as in our churches! May the Lord use this seminar to help all of us to discern the false from the real, and then instruct those who have been deceived so that they can return to the truth. We have been called by God to stand on the truth and proclaim it courageously!

Conclusion and Summary

The thesis of our study today is that much of the modern charismatic movement is causing confusion in many churches all over the world. According to **Chapter 14**, we have learned that God desires order and balance instead of confusion—as stated in our theme verse, "God is not the author of confusion." Therefore, we as church leaders have an awesome responsibility to make sure that we do our best to lovingly and firmly warn those within our churches who are causing the confusion. If there is no repentance and change of behavior, we must take appropriate action according to **Matthew 18** to expel them from our fellowships. In addition, we must make sure that we have come to a resolute conclusion in our own beliefs about the charismatic doctrines, and then teach the truth to our parishioners.

In addition to all that has been said, if our churches are dead, formal, ritualistic, spiritually cold, and void of the Holy Spirit's presence, we need to get on our knees before the Lord and ask Him to begin manifesting His holy presence in our services. If we believe that only form and ritual constitute genuine worship, we need our hearts changed to where we can experience a vital living relationship with Jesus Christ, and then share that experience with our pastors and parishioners in the churches. If we are going to stop the flow of experience seeking people from leaving our churches for the charismatic doctrines, we must provide them with the alternative of a true and living experience with our wonderful Lord and Savior. In other words, we must preach Jesus Christ, crucified, resurrected, and coming again in our churches. With this proclamation, we must call people to repentance and a born-again experience of salvation. If there is no personal salvation in the lives of our people because all we have is religion, they are going to steadily gravitate to the counterfeit charismatics. May the Lord help us to pattern and proclaim the truth that Jesus is alive, and that we can be filled with His Holy Spirit without acting silly or foolishly as many are doing today. We must act now concerning this matter. If we don't, we soon may be "guarding the chicken house after the chickens have run away"!!!!
