Dear GIMI Team Members,

We have just completed the wonderful Christmas Evangelism rallies in the prisons and schools of our 15 African countries where we work, and I am thrilled to share with you the following report. During the rallies in Uganda, we were able to provide meat and complete Christmas meals for thousands of prisoners. Additionally, we provided many thousands of dollars' worth of other Christmas gifts for the prisoners, prison children, school students, and some orphans in all of our African countries, plus a lot of Christmas items in the Ukraine. We were able to provide, rice, beans, bread, cooking oil, juice, bananas, and a lot of other food items. Also, we gave gifts of toilet tissue, soap,

feminine hygiene items, facemasks, liquid hand soaps, Vaseline, blankets, rubber sandals, clothing, and a lot of medicine. But most of all, the greatest gift we gave was the presentation of the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, which hundreds responded to positively and got saved.

We sincerely believe this was the greatest Christmas ministry we have had in over 21 years since Jo Anne and I took over this great work for Jesus, in spite of the Covid plague. At this point, we have already shared the Gospel message with over 1,061,992 people in our 15 countries during this past year, and from this large number of people, God gave us a harvest of over 166,000 praying to receive Christ. Like the shepherds when they returned from Bethlehem, we are praising God and giving Him all the glory for what He did during the year just passed, and for the tremendous blessings God has given us during the Christmas celebrations! Because of you dear friends who are a part of our team, you too will share in the rewards for this tremendous harvest from the fields that were waiting to be gathered even in the midst of the Covid plague. Thank you for your regular investments in GIMI, but also, thank you for the extra funds you gave to help us buy the cows and provide all of the gifts this Christmas. By your help, we were able to raise over \$50,000.00 to buy the cows, plus the huge amount of other Christmas gifts that were distributed along with preaching the Gospel message about the coming of our Lord and Savior. The Nation Of Israel Had Many New Beginnings

As I think about this past year, which went by so quickly, probably because of the pandemic, I look to the future with enthusiasm, and I can't help but think about the nation of Israel, God's chosen nation, and how that so many times they went through tremendous episodes of suffering and hardship because of their disobedience and rebellion toward God. Yet, we know that our wonderful forgiving God always brought the repenting people to a point of new beginnings—at least a remnant of the multitudes.

One good illustration of God's giving them a new beginning occurred just after Moses died on Mt. Pisgah, and then God called Joshua to become the leader of the Israelites and to take them into the Land of Promise. Bear in mind that they could have gone directly from Egypt to the Promised Land in just about three weeks, but because of their disobedience to the command of God and their fear of the human giants in the land, they spent the next forty years in the wilderness with multitudes of their people dying there. Then, after all of those years of wandering in the wilderness, God gave the new generation of Israelites the privilege of starting over under the leadership of Joshua. Let's take a look at nine verses of wonderful Scripture about this new beginning for the people of God.

Joshua 1:1-9—*"Now after the death of Moses the servant of the Lord it came to pass, that the Lord spake unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying, Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give them, even to the children of Israel. Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses. From the wilderness and this Lebanon even unto the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and unto the great sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your coast. There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee: nor forsake thee. Be strong and of a good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I swore unto their*

fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou may prosper whithersoever thou goest. This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success. Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the Lord thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest."

In this wonderful passage of Scripture, God emphatically told Joshua and the Israelites that if they would be obedient to His law every day, if they would study and live by His Word, and if they would go with courage and His strength, trusting in the Lord, then they would indeed be successful and claim the Promised Land away from the evil enemy tribes. May I say that if we are going to claim new land or territory away from the enemy this coming year, then we, like the Israelites, must live by the Book, exercise great faith in the Father, have courage enough to cross over the Jordan, and get out of our comfort zones. Then, we must appropriate the presence of God every day in our lives because He has promised to never leave us, but He has promised to give us the victory in such a way that we will be prosperous in the work of the Lord if our motives and goals are right.

Not one of us knows what this New Year will hold for us, but we must be ready to claim by faith new territory for our Lord Jesus Christ. If we do this by God's way and plan, we will indeed be very successful, and He will be right there with us every day of this laborious journey. May I ask all of you GIMI team members to stick with us as we try to claim the land God has promised to us. If we will exercise faith in our wonderful Savior and stay faithful to the very end, He will give us a tremendous harvest during 2022. Let's sincerely believe it, and let us surrender our lives to Him in order to accomplish His Divine will for each of our individual lives.

Another Great Passage Dealing With Thanksgiving And Giving!

I know that we have just begun a New Year after closing out the past two extremely difficult years with the horrible enemy of the coronavirus. During the past couple of months, we have been talking a lot about giving thanks, and also we have been giving many wonderful gifts during the Christmas Season. Because of our tremendous emphasis upon thanking God for His many blessings and because of the spirit of giving, which we have recently demonstrated by giving gifts to those we love, I want to share a long passage of Scripture on continuing to live a life of daily thanksgiving and continual giving because of our love for Jesus and the work of His Kingdom. A lot of the commentary, which I am giving you is from my new written commentary on the Book of II Corinthians which Paul wrote to the church at Corinth while they were dealing with stingy false teachers who were causing problems in the body of Christ. It is my prayer as I write this GIMI Newsletter that every one of us will become sacrificial givers for the rest of our lives here on earth. So now, please pay diligent attention to the following passage of Scripture and the comments I have written on this wonderful text from God's Word!

"But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work: (As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth forever. Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;) Being enriched in everything to all bountifulness, which causeth through us thanksgiving to God. For the administration of this service not only supplieth the want of the saints; but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God; Whiles by the experiment of this ministration they glorify God for your professed subjection unto

the Gospel of Christ, and for your liberal distribution unto them, and unto all men; And by their prayer for you, which long after you for the exceeding grace of God in you. Thanks be unto God for His unspeakable gift." (II Corinthians 9:6-15).

This is quite a long passage of Scripture, but it is filled with Biblical truth and principles. Some of those principles are:

1. We must learn to give bountifully, for if we don't, our harvest will be sparse. v. 6
2. We must learn to give bountifully with a Godly purpose in mind. v. 7a
3. We must learn to give cheerfully, because God loves a cheerful giver. v. 7b
4. We must learn to give to others, because God will give more grace when grace has been shown to others. v. 8a
5. We must learn to completely depend upon the graciousness of God in His meeting our every need, so that in turn, we may do good work in ministering to others. v. 8b
6. We must learn to give to the poor because this righteous deed will never be forgotten by our Lord. v. 9
7. We must learn to trust God to provide our food, and we demonstrate this trust when we sow good seed by investing in others who are in need. v. 10
8. We must learn that when we give bountifully by investing in those who are poor and suffering, then others will offer thanksgiving to God because of what we have done in His name. v. 11
9. We must learn that when we give offerings to minister to those in need, like those in the Jerusalem church for which the Corinthians were receiving an offering, then, those to whom we have given will offer much thanksgiving to God for our ministry to them. v. 12
10. We must learn that when we give offerings to help those in need, we are displaying that we are genuine believers who are truly sharing liberally because of our relationship with Christ. v. 13
11. We must learn that when we minister to the suffering, then they are prone to offer fervent prayers on our behalf. v. 14a

12. We must learn that when we minister to the suffering, then, the recipients of our ministry will prayerfully long for the type of graciousness we have demonstrated to them. v. 14b
13. We must learn that the greatest way to offer true thanksgiving is to demonstrate help to alleviate the suffering of those who are hurting, who in turn will thank God for the unspeakable gift of the Gospel message. v. 15

Now, what is the summary of all of these Biblical principles that Paul gave to the Corinthian church and to us as well? The summary of this is that when we as God's people learn the joy of giving cheerfully to those who are in need of the Gospel or are in tremendous poverty, then we have demonstrated the true Gospel message. Thus, those who give cheerfully will be offering thanksgiving for the privilege to give, and then those who receive from our kind generosity will also offer tremendous praise and thanksgiving to God for touching our hearts to lead us to give! In other words, there will be Thanksgiving all around!

We Are Still Available To Visit Some Churches!

As I move on with my article in this newsletter, I just want to mention that even with the Covid Crisis in our country for the past two years, Jo Anne and I have prayed much about the importance of visiting some of our supporting churches, plus hopefully, to visit some new churches as well. We would love to get into some new churches to share with you dear pastors and church families about what God has been doing through our GIMI ministry in Africa during the last 22 years. Truly, we have seen the Book of Acts come to life right before our very eyes. We would love to share with everyone about what Jesus is doing on all of our African mission fields and in Ukraine as well. In fact, over the past 22 years since my wife and I took over this ministry, GIMI will soon be privileged, by February, to have shared the Gospel message with over 14 million people. And more importantly, out of these 14 million people, we have seen 3.5 million of them make first time decisions for Christ! For this wonderful miracle, we are praising God.

We Have Finally Restarted Our Radio Ministry!

Folks, even with the horrible days of the Covid pandemic, God has given us a great harvest of souls because of the faithfulness of our national preachers and teachers. But, we must admit that because we here in America can't travel to our fields like we used to before the pandemic, we do need to expand our ministry in other ways. Well, because my voice is much improved after vocal cord surgery, we are restarted our radio ministry on January 1, 2022. As we are restarting the radio ministry, we need to have additional supporters and more people involved in this ministry. With restarting the radio ministry, we also hope to continue to expand it. There is no doubt that we can share the Gospel message with millions of people, with the possibility of thousands coming to Christ. Jo Anne and I really want to see this ministry reach as many people as possible. We sincerely believe that there is no better way to get the Gospel out during these difficult days than through our revived radio ministry. We have presently reconnected with the 65 stations we used to be on before my vocal cord became paralyzed. If my voice becomes strong again, I am praying that we might be able to up our broadcasting expansion to at least 80 stations, hopefully, with at least 20 of these being in Africa. If we are going to be able to do this, I must ask for your prayers for my health, including the restoration of my voice. Also, if we do expand our coasts as Jabez prayed, we must increase the giving to our radio ministry due to the fact that it is going to require \$60,000 to \$70,000 per year to make it possible to reach this huge audience of people, both here in America and in Africa.



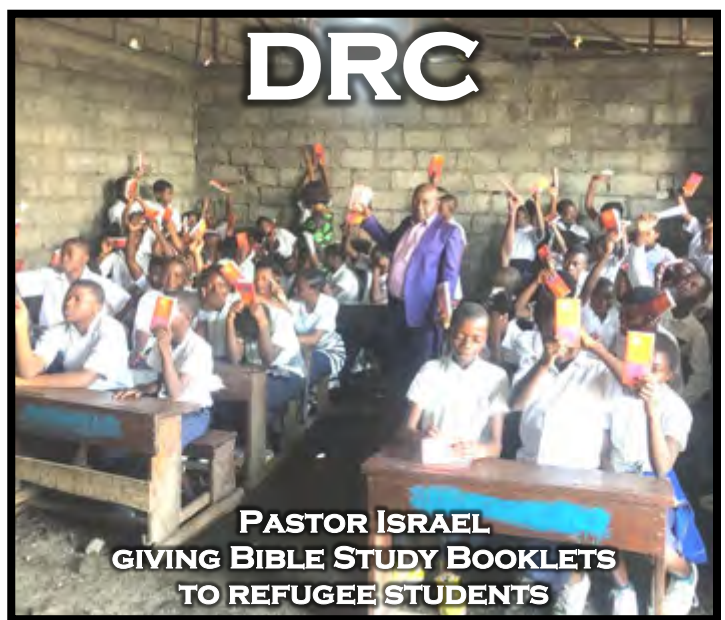
I would like to tell you folks that just recently, Dr. David Gallamore, pastor of the great Rock Springs Baptist Church in Easley, S.C., challenged his congregation to use the prayer of Jabez as a pattern for their praying in 2022, following the terrible downsizing during the two year pandemic. So, let me encourage each of you GIMI Team Members to also follow the pattern of prayer that Jabez has given to all of us. If you have attended a banquet or special meeting here at our GIMI Headquarters, you know that just as you step into our front room foyer of our building, the first thing you will see is the prayer of Jabez upon a large photo on the wall. This prayer has been a roadmap for GIMI for a long time. Thus, I would encourage you to read this Scripture in First Chronicles over and over, and ask God to do for you what Jabez prayed for as well. So, let me ask you to read carefully the following verses of Scripture, and let me remind you of this great prayer of Jabez found in **I Chronicles 4:9-10**. Pay attention to these two verses and join me regularly in praying this same prayer. ***"And Jabez was more honorable than his brethren: and his mother called his name Jabez, saying, Because I bare him with sorrow. And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested."*** I pray God will do the same for GIMI!

Well, let me close this section of our GIMI Newsletter by telling all of you that Jo Anne and I do sincerely love you, and we appreciate everything you have done and will do for the growth of GIMI. Please don't ever hesitate to call us if we can help you and your church in any way. Please know that we are praying that God will give you a wonderful New Year!

We Are Praying For The Doors To Open So That Our Mission Teams Can Return To Africa!

During the past several months, quite a few of you have contacted me about the possibility of going on a mission trip back to Africa. We all know that the pandemic has really affected and restricted the opportunity for people to travel back and forth from other countries to America. The different restrictions in all of our African countries have been not only confusing, but they have also been so different that we can't determine if people could fly safely, have to wear masks on all flights, have to be in quarantine for several days once the teams arrive in Africa, and of course, most recently, with the coming of the Omicron virus, our own President has prematurely stopped flights from at least eight countries in Africa. So, we honestly don't know how to plan or project for our mission teams to go share the Gospel and minister to a lot of suffering people at the present moment.

I do want to tell you that my son, Pastor Joel Frye is still planning to take a Medical/Evangelism team back to Uganda and Kenya just as soon as things open up. Pastor Joel had put a tremendous team together for a trip back in the late spring of 2020, when the plague hit all of us. Therefore, the team could not make this trip. This team is still excited about going again. So, I ask all of you to really help us pray for God to kill the virus, open the doors, and of course, put together the teams that He wants to go and represent GIMI. In the past, Jo Anne and I have taken over 300 people to Africa on mission trips to preach, teach, witness, conduct medical clinics, and to do a lot of other ministries in the prisons, schools, orphanages, and churches in order to share the love of Jesus and the Gospel message. Thus, we just need to pray that the doors will swing wide open for all of us and that Jesus will put together the teams He wants to use to win lost people to Him. And to seem a little drastic, let me tell you that we must do everything we can to win people to Jesus, because time is running out before Jesus comes. Now, if you think we are using fear tactics to enlist mission team members, let me just

tell you that we aren't. But, if we can watch all of these TV ads with medicine sales people and scores of other items being advertised through fear tactics, I believe we might use many other types of tactics to try and win people to Christ, including the certainty of death and the judgment of Christ to come. Yes, as all of us have witnessed over the past two years, many people have faced imminent death because of the horrible disease, which has been a terrible thing. But, it is even more horrible for those who are facing death without being saved and having Jesus in their hearts. So, let's pray for God to open doors and that He will once again lead and direct people to make a journey for Jesus to win people for Him. "Truly, the fields are yet white unto harvest!"

We Are Now In The Process Of Providing Teaching DVDs

I would like to share with all of you on our GIMI Team that in recent months following the surgery on my vocal cords, I have once again begun some radio broadcasts. I have also started producing some teaching videos to hopefully help all of the pastors I can here in America and provide some tremendous teaching videos for our preachers, teachers, and other church leaders in Africa, who want so much to become better equipped to share the Word of God, and to train other workers. So, I will mention that on our GIMI website, you can find many of my teaching videos, which you can download for free. But also, we are beginning to produce some messages on DVD's if you would like to have some of these to improve your ministry. The first set of DVDs is entitled, "Finishing The Task God Has Given Us." This is a series of 15 DVD teaching sessions on how to better equip yourselves to do the work that God has given us and to fulfill the responsibilities that go along with being a faithful and fruitful church leader. If you have the funds, we are asking for a donation of \$25.00 from our American church leaders. But, if you don't have the funds to send a donation, then, just let us know, and we will send the set of DVD's to you absolutely free there in Africa, but also, here in America. I sincerely believe that this set of training videos will be a great help to your ministry.

Also, I would like to tell you that I am presently

working on some more teaching materials that can be used to help you with your ministry and to do a better job of reaching the lost world with the Gospel message! I will be offering some of these new DVDs to our radio listening audience just as soon as I possibly can.

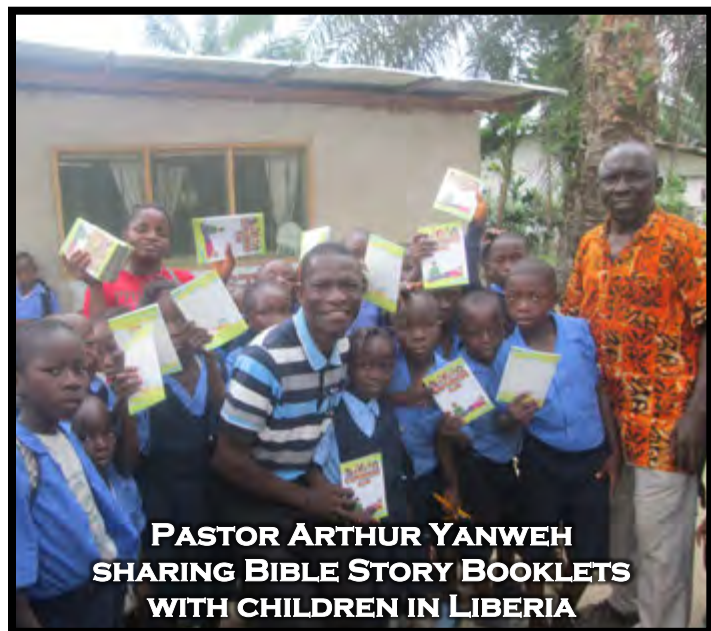
So, just keep praying for this old senior preacher!

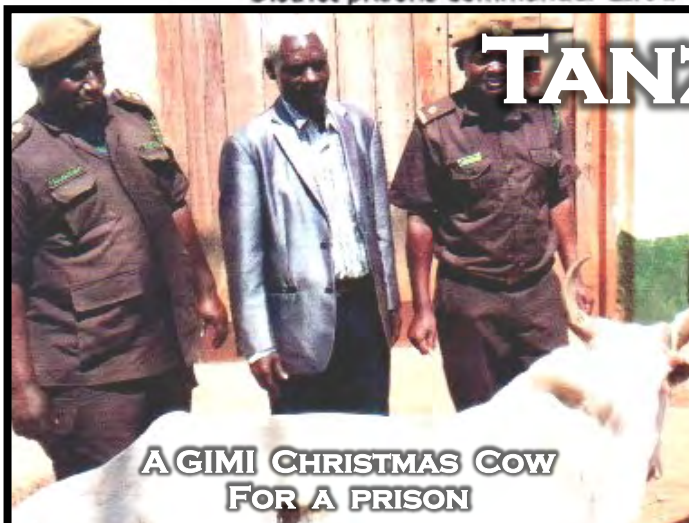
