# AN UPDATE ON WHAT JESUS HAS BEEN DOING!

Folks, I am sure that some of you might get tired of hearing about what God is doing through GIMI. But, I must tell you that I am thrilled to meditate on the glorious goodness of God, when it comes to the harvest He is giving this ministry! So, let me ask you to pay close attention to the following information, which I pray will get you newly excited about the marvelous Book of Acts harvest God is giving to us.

I would like to give you the following numbers from our regular monthly ministry reports from which we get these glorious totals. So, let me give you some statistics that God has given us down through the past 23 years since my precious wife and I took over this wonderful ministry for Jesus! During these years, GIMI has shared the Gospel with just over 30,912,000 people 5,255,040 making first-time professions of faith in Christ. Will you just stop and join me in shouting hallelujah to the Lamb of God for this huge harvest? We have truly been blessed far beyond understanding to be a part of this great proclamation of the Gospel, which has resulted in this Book of Acts harvest of souls! Surely, surely, we have witnessed firsthand a mighty miracle of God before our very eyes! As the great Psalm 126 tells us, we have gone forth weeping bearing precious seed, and we have come home over and over again rejoicing bringing our sheaves with us! And then, oh yes, our staff and workers have also done an enormous amount of discipleship with these converts to help them grow in grace. This has been done through our GIMI workers, many pastors, and a huge amount of teaching and training. And just for you doubters and naysayers, you are right. I don't believe all of these professions of faith were genuine any more than I believe that all of our church members sitting on pews and benches every Sunday are saved. As I told you before, one time while I was preaching as the warm-up preacher for Dr. David Jeremiah in Woodstock, GA., after the meeting that day several preachers and I went out to eat a meal with Dr. Jeremiah. Across the table from him, I asked Dr. Jeremiah just what percentage of church members did he believe were genuinely saved. He responded immediately and said, "only 25%." Then, I asked him where he got this percentage. He then replied, "from the Parable of the Sower." "There were four kinds of soil where the seed were planted, but only one of the four was genuine." So, my dear doubter friends, before you criticize us or any other ministry, you just need to stop and give a genuine Christian test of all of your church members. I believe you will discover that most of them are not really saved. I know this has been true for the 11 churches I have pastored. Twenty-five percent or less of the members have always done all the work and given all of the

money! Also, when I look back at the churches that my wife and I have led down through 58 years of ministry, I have learned disappointingly that scores of our former church members are now out of church, living in ungodly sin, even to the depths of the debauchery of homosexuality, lesbianism, and other horrible sins. By the way, many of these that are now on the road to hell used to be musicians, singers, teachers, preachers, missionaries, and other Christian positions. Therefore, I am not going to quit doing evangelism on the radio, in crusades, churches, schools, orphanages, and large refugee camps. So, praise the Lord for having the privilege of working with this "God-anointed ministry for Him."

## Some More Wonderful Statistics

Before moving on with this "getting longer" article, I would like to share some more wonderful blessings given to GIMI over the history of our ministry. A lot of you know that before JoAnne and I took over this wonderful ministry 23 years ago, we worked nonstop with Brother Mickey and Sister Alice Parrish who started the ministry way back in the mid-19 seventies. These precious people are now with Jesus, but, during those 15 years that we worked diligently with them, God gloriously blessed us to help do a huge amount of things to present the Gospel to thousands of people, and to help distribute tons of humanitarian assistance to alleviate the suffering of thousands of people in churches, hospitals, prisons, schools, orphanages, and in recent years, in the huge refugee camps in several of our African countries. During all of our 38 years, GIMI has distributed almost 40 million dollars worth of humanitarian assistance to millions of people in order just to show them that Jesus loved them, and to get the opportunity to share the Gospel with them. And, in order to share appreciation, I would like to tell you that some of this assistance came through Samaritan's Purse who helped us refurbish three hospitals in African prisons. And, I want to share with you that since January of 2022, the month before the Russian War began in February, GIMI, with the help of people who have given designated funds, have sent almost \$50,000 to Pastor Dima Bulakh, to help him with the horrible situation while ministering to hundreds of suffering people. And, I want to add that absolutely none of this great ministry would ever been possible were it not for you dear friends who have helped us by praying, and by giving regularly to this ministry. **THEREFORE, BE AWARE OF WHAT JESUS TOLD HIS DISCIPLES IN MATTHEW 10, WHEN HE WAS SENDING THEM FORTH WITH THE GREAT COMMISSION. HE TOLD THEM THAT AS THEY TRAVELED FROM TOWN TO TOWN AND VILLAGE TO VILLAGE, WHOEVER RE-**

Before I close this section of my article, I want to once more mention some very wonderful statistics that I am sure all of you will be thrilled to learn. Earlier in this newsletter, I gave you the stats for all of the years my wife and I have been working in Africa. Now, I just want to mention what has happened since January of 2022 up until the climax of January 2023. During these 13 months, we have been blessed to share the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ with 1,645,000 people. This does include many of the radio converts. Therefore, I am sure that all of you will rejoice to know that during these 13 months, God has gloriously given us a harvest of 322,751 making their first-time profession of faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. We are truly praising God for this miraculous harvest! Yes, we are surely thrilled with this large number of people coming to Christ. But, we must never forget that there are still three billion people out of eight billion that have never heard one presentation of the Gospel. Thus, GIMI friends and team members, we can't stop now. We must continue to share the Gospel message with as many people as possible during these days when so many churches are cold and dying, when pastors are searching for excuses to not go soul-winning, when damnable doctrines like Neo-Calvanism have become the center in what-used-to-be dynamic soul-winning churches, like First Baptist Church of Jacksonville, Florida, where under the leadership of Dr. Homer Lindsay Jr., thousands came to Christ every year. Then too, since the terrible Covid crisis, churches have either been so frightened that they are afraid to go soul-winning, or maybe, some have become so unconcerned for souls that they are using Covid as an excuse to not promote winning people to Christ. Most all of you know that for three years very few people have been able to travel internationally because of the Covid plague. This has been especially difficult for many of our regular Mission Teams who have been going back and forth to Uganda, Kenya, Rwanda, Burundi, and many other countries for a long time. Then, of course, due to my unpredictable health problems, my wife and I have not been able to travel back to our beloved Africa for the past three years as well. And then, I haven't been able to travel far from home here in America either because of the constant pain from several illnesses, difficulty in walking because of neuropathy, and because of my inability to eat certain foods. Thus, my wife and I have been limited in what we can actually do in Africa, which we have continued since 1985. But, I will tell you that as a 75 year-old preacher and wife who have been in full-time ministry for almost 58 years, we are now working harder and longer each day than we ever have. But, during the past three years, while we have been limited, our national workers have worked extremely hard in the midst of dire

Covid and even, new government rules and regulations. Of course, we all know just how crazy our American wicked, vicious, and yes, ignorant, leaders have lied to us almost every time they have opened their mouths about the Covid problems, including vaccinations, vulnerability, and medical science. Truly, I believe that the more dedicated we become in our efforts to win people to Christ, the more attacks we will be getting from Satan himself. Honestly, I just can wait until one day I will see Satan cast into the Lake of Fire forever! (Revelation 20:10)

Well, before I get lost in another long sermon, let me tell you that there is just no way that we could ever have reaped the great harvest God has given to us without the tremendous work of all of our national workers in all of our African countries, and yes, without the devotion and help of our GIMI Board members. # OUR RADIO MINISTRY IS GROWING AND PRODUCING A MAGNIFICENT HARVEST!

In the past few GIMI Newsletters I have talked with you a lot about the horrible circumstances with my throat, which required vocal cord implant surgery back in 2021. Also, I was forced to discontinue the radio programs due to the voice problems. Then, after the surgery, things were looking better. So, once again we restarted our broadcasts. Then, I had another setback with my throat, which required another delay of the radio broadcasts. I stopped in late May of last year, and for the second time, I began broadcasting in September. Well, praise God, from then until now, I have been able to continue the radio production. And folks, God has had His marvelous big hand on this ministry since we began again!

Presently, we are on 37 stations, with 17 of these is in Africa. God has really been blessing this huge ministry with another great harvest of souls. But, I will tell you that if every station did for us what Esther Nakyagulanyi and Anna Uweera are doing at the Dunamis Radio Station in Kampala, Uganda, and, in the Grace Radio Station in Western Uganda. These precious people have been working laboriously to win people to Jesus through our weekly 30-minute broadcasts. And, I am sad to tell you that we have no other station in all of Africa that is giving this same attention to trying to reach people with the Gospel. Oh yes, I am very thankful for the small number of people that have gotten saved through our many other stations. But, we are not seeing anywhere near the huge number of souls come to Christ like Dunamis and Grace Radio in Uganda. I am so very thankful for the extra effort that Esther and Annie are demonstrating to see more people get saved. I would ask you to really pray for these dear ladies and their families. We have already seen Satan attacking these ladies in the tragic death of a precious little boy that was born to Annie and her husband. Please pray that God will surely comfort Annie and her husband. And also, please help us pray a protective hedge around these ladies and the Dunamis and Grace Stations. There is nothing on earth that Satan hates as much as he does soul-winning individuals, soul-winning churches, and yes, great soul-winning radio stations!

Hopefully, in the not too distant future, we will be able to have a close number to the actual costs for the travel and activities to and within both Kenya and Uganda. 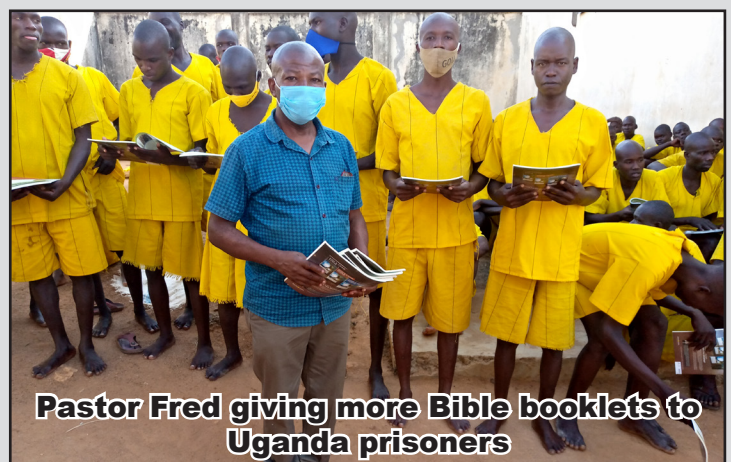

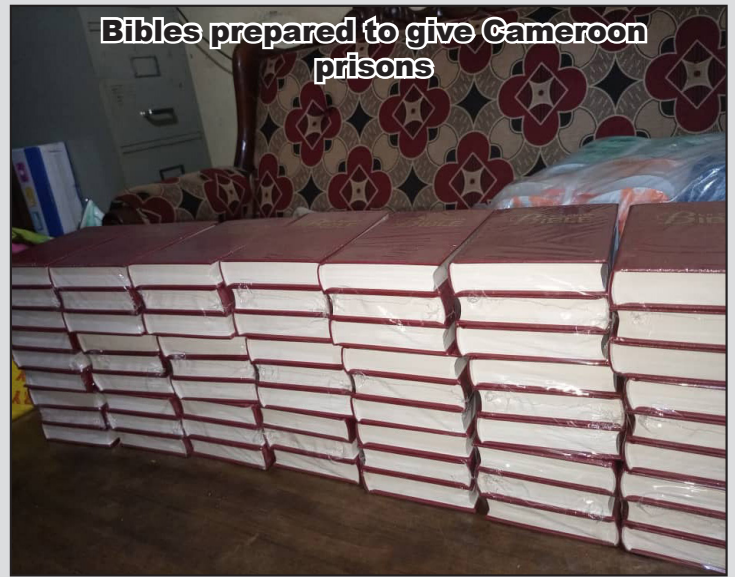

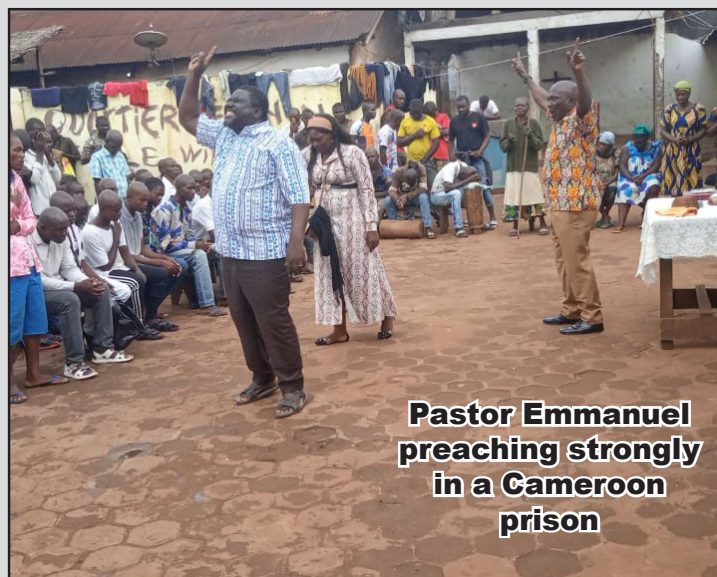

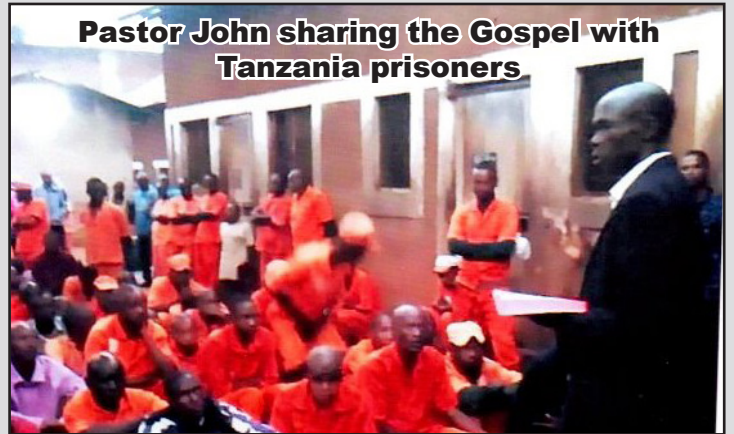
