

A Tremendous Tribute To Pastor Julius Tugume, One Of God's Great Faithful Servants In Uganda: Now With Jesus!

I am literally crying today because I have a broken heart. Most of you that receive our GIMI Newsletters by email, already know about the horrible tragedy that happened to one of our great and faithful preachers in Uganda just a couple weekends back. God has blessed GIMI with 53 daily preachers and teachers in 12 African countries where we minister every month. In Uganda, we have had 13 workers for a long time. Let me tell you about one of these great servants of God!

Many years ago, when JoAnne and I started working in Uganda, we started sharing the Gospel in many prisons. One of these large prisons is in Eastern Uganda. It was in this large prison we first met inmate Julius Tugume, who had been in prison for several years. It was in this large prison where Julius got gloriously saved through the ministry of one of our GIMI Uganda ministry teams. After he got saved, Julius really began to study the Bible, pray fervently, and he became a soul-winner in prison. Later the prison church called him to be their pastor. He was truly a dedicated servant of Jesus. Ouite a long time went by, and eventually, he was freed from prison. Then, we brought Julius on board to work with our GIMI teams all over Uganda. He later helped plant a couple local churches, while he continued to work with our GIMI Team. He became, what I would call, a very strong pastor/evangelist. Brother Julius helped GIMI win

thousands of lost people to Christ. In fact, just recently when Pastor Joel Frve took Joev Brown to Uganda, they shared the Gospel in many prisons with the faithful assistance of Pastor Julius. Because Satan hates faithful servants of God, he decided to try and stop Pastor Julius from continuing to win thousands of souls for Jesus. After Brother Joey Brown and Pastor Joel completed their short evangelism mission on Saturday a few weeks ago, on the next day, Sunday morning, Pastor welcoming **Iulius** was his Sunday morning worshippers. A vicious, wicked drug addict showed up in front of Pastor Julius' church, and tried to force his way into the church. Pastor Julius and some of his men tried to stop the wicked man from coming into the church. In the scuffle that ensued, the drug addict withdrew a knife and stabbed Pastor Julius to death there near the entrance to the church. This evil, drugaddict was spared, and is now in jail. Pastor Julius is now in Heaven with Jesus! He left behind his beloved mother and three of his brother's children, with broken hearts. Julius had been taking care of his mom and his brother's children. Now this fragile woman is left to take care of these precious grandchildren. Please pray





My wife and I believe God has great plans for Alicia and her family, even after having to spend thirteen years in prison!

We Revived Our Radio Ministry By Replaying Previous Broadcasts At Three Stations In Uganda

In one of our recent GIMI newsletters, I mentioned I had to discontinue radio broadcasts because of new health problems that would not permit me the strength to do the programs. I then told you that three stations in Uganda, were replaying older broadcasts. I am thrilled to tell you we are continuing with this revived ministry while praying God might heal my body and give me back strength to resume the entire radio ministry. I am thrilled to tell you God really continues to bless this radio ministry. Presently, we are averaging almost 2,000 people getting saved each month through this wonderful ministry. We are praising God for this great harvest of souls!

I want to literally beg you dear GIMI Team Members, first, to pray for God to give me the strength to continue this great radio ministry very soon. Secondly, we really need your financial help to pay for the airtime. Airtime these days is very expensive, but, beloved friends, because of the hundreds and hundreds of people that are being saved through this ministry, it is surely worth the cost, because Jesus is returning very soon. I mentioned earlier, there are two billion people on this earth who have never been saved, and most of them have not even heard or seen the plan of salvation.

Dear beloved GIMI Friends, if you have been reading our bi-monthly newsletter for the past couple years, I am sure you have read about the dedication of so many of our radio managers. They have been so faithful in helping us get the Gospel message out to thousands of lost people in many African countries. About 18 months ago, I had to stop recording the weekly broadcasts because of sickness. Having to stop recording the programs, forced us to cancel the weekly radio broadcasts in many cities. A few of our radio workers didn't want to cancel the broadcasts. With the approval of the radio management, they continued on with the weekly broadcast replaying our broadcasts. The faithfulness of these dear servants has allowed God to continue to reap a huge harvest of souls. We are very grateful for the faithfulness of all our workers. I am especially grateful for Sister Esther Nakyagulanyi, who has done a phenomenal job of helping us reach thousands of lost sinners for Iesus. Esther has a tremendous burden for lost sinners to come to Christ! In addition to seeing many people come to Christ through replaying the radio broadcast, Sister Esther also takes the Gospel to hundreds and hundreds of children in the Uganda schools. She shares the Gospel with scores of children by replaying the radio broadcasts that we shared with the radio audience. I am including some of her work in the schools in this newsletter. Pastor Joel's Final Report From His June/July Mission Trip To Uganda And Kenya

I want to express my sincere thanks to our son, Pastor Joel Frye and his team that recently went to Uganda and Kenya in June and July, to share the Gospel message. The team reached thousands of lost prisoners, school students, and refugees who so desperately needed the Good News of the Gospel. God blessed and protected Joel's team as they traveled thousands of miles by plane and by vehicles on terrible roads.

The greatest blessing was the huge harvest of souls that were saved with the team's dedicated efforts. Let me give you Pastor Joel's final report of the trip! I hope you will rejoice with us as we reflect on what God did through His servants. I pray you will join us in praising Jesus for this great harvest of souls. Let's praise Him for the gifts God provided through you, our supporters, to help the many suffering people!

"Dad, from my best calculations with both John in Uganda and Sammy in Kenya, we were in 22 prisons, 7 schools, and one church. We shared the Gospel with 12,306 people, and had 2,558 people pray to receive Christ! Additionally, we distributed 85 boxes of bar soap, 23 boxes of liquid soap, 209 boxes of sanitary pads, 18 boxes of baby diapers, 20 soccer balls, and 140 units of Christian reading material. We gave over 75 new outfits to children in prisons with their moms, along with lollipops, and toys. Other items given included volleyballs, razor blades, a rechargeable battery speaker, T-shirts, and more!"

Dear beloved GIMI friends and Team Members, we would never have been able to help so many suffering people, if it had not been for your diligent prayers and generous giving. From the depths of our hearts, JoAnne and I want to thank every one of you special supporters for the success of this mission trip and soul-winning expedition.

Thank you for your sacrificial investment of time and generosity. May God bless you richly for your kindness and love for lost sinners!

A Letter and Pictures from our Pastor in the Ukraine

Dear brother Pastor Stan! Greetings!

Thank you for your care and love for us. We continue to be at war, ... a real war that kills, that torments and that threatens our entire Ukrainian people. Another night full of anxiety and a day full of sirens, this time the alarm echoed from the evening of the previous day all night long.

Kyiv has its own subway, and every night tens of thousands of people with their children spend on the floor of the stations to hide from the explosions of drones and ballistic missiles. We have not attacked anyone, we do not need someone else's land, but we are suffering because the enemy has no fear of God or people. As of this morning, a private house, a car and an outbuilding were damaged in one district of our region. Thanks to God, people were not injured this time. The day camp again brought together almost forty children. We see how today the children lack the usual joy, and their parents lack hope. We thank Christ for He is our hope, which we can share with those around us. But the enemy does not leave us alone. Almost at the end of the camp, we barely had time to feed the children when an air raid alarm and the launch of enemy missiles forced us to take them off the street and into a bomb shelter. But God is alive, we are serving and thank you all for your prayers for us! Last Sunday, one of the oldest parishioners of the church, Sister Nadezhda, made a covenant with the Lord Jesus and received water baptism. She is eighty-seven years old and can barely walk with a cane, but she could not resist obeying God. We continue to baptize people. Our team on the road to prisons every week. Last night we have again three prisoners who opened their hearts to Jesus. We praise the Lord that His hand is over us even now. Thank you all for your generous prayers and support. Missing you dear brother Pastor.
