 - 1. This settlement requires a personal faith. v. 17a
 - 2. This settlement requires a proper footing. v. 17b
 - 3. This settlement requires a passionate foundation. v. 17c
- C. His petition included a prayer for sense. v. 18-19a
 - 1. Paul prays for the believers to sense the scope of Christ’s love. v. 18
 - 2. Paul prays for the believers to sense the scale of Christ’s love. v. 19a
- D. His petition included a prayer for saturation. v. 19b
